Outdoor use of drinking water

By-law 667 regulates the use of water distributed by the municipal water supply system. If you use drinking water outdoors, please respect the following conditions.

It is forbidden at all times to:

- O Clean driveways, parking lots or sidewalks;
- Organize a car wash fundraiser;
- ♦ Water the lawn when it's raining:
- Solution Fill a swimming pool completely: you must contact a water-truck filling service;
- O Let drinking water run off the ground, onto an impermeable surface, the street or neighboring properties;
- O Use a non-compliant automatic sprinkler system (see By-law 667, section 8);
- Use water as an energy source, notably to operate a sump pump.

Periods when watering vegetation is authorized May 1st to August 31 only

Washing cars, walls and windows is permitted, on condition that it is done with a manual watering system (watering gun).



Fines

Any person infringing the by-law commits an offence and is liable to a fine of up to \$4,000.

In case of disparity between this document and the By-law 667, the by-law takes precedence.
